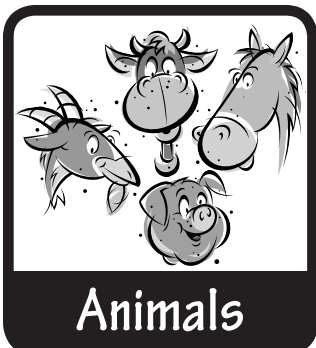

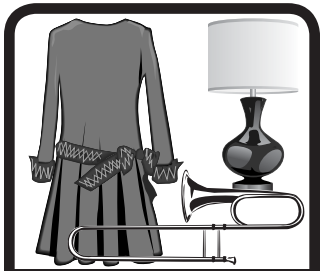

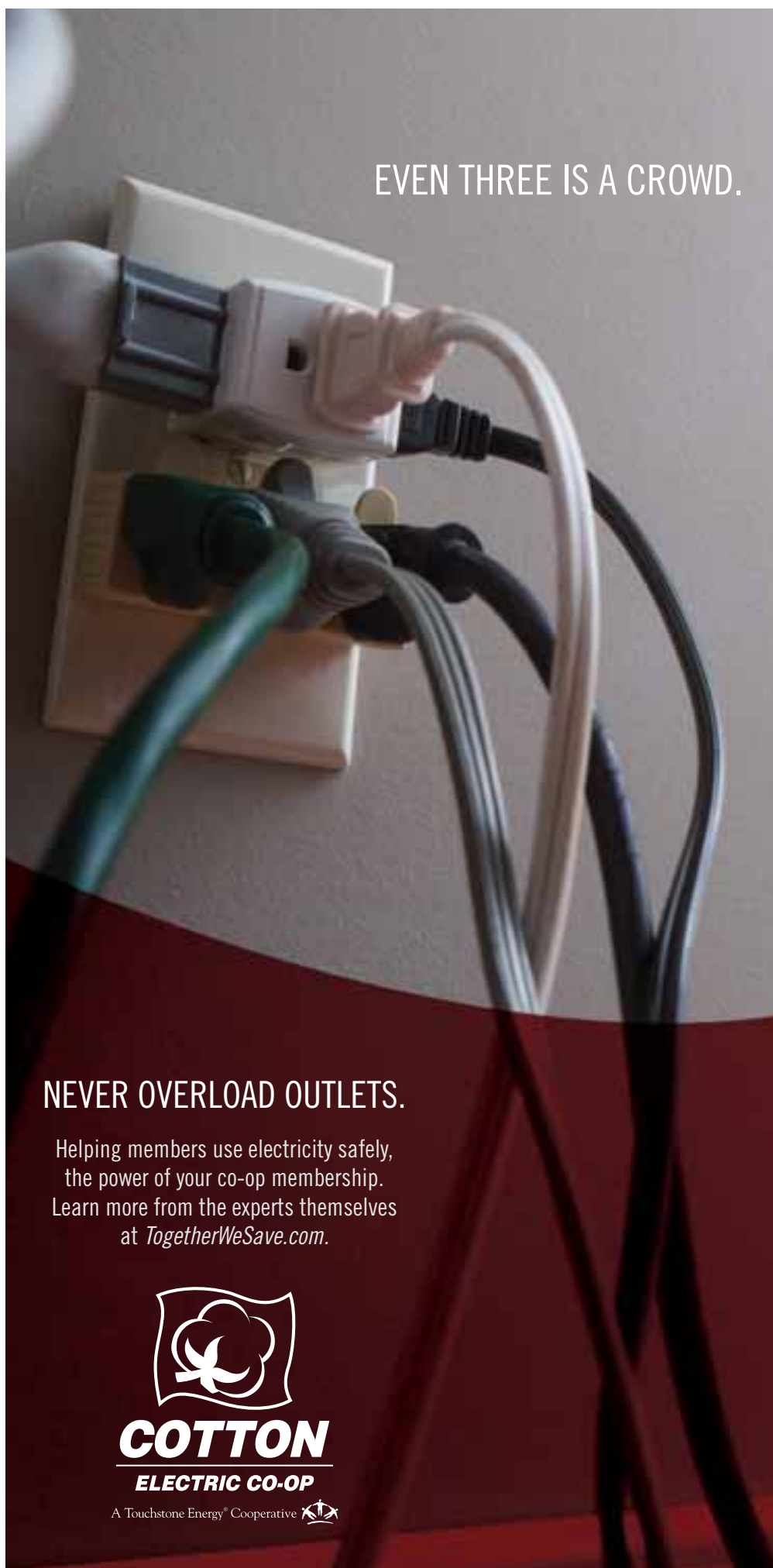
This spring, there will be two changes to Cotton Electric billing cycles:
